Health centre constructed

CHAURATA, March 6 : With donations collected by students of Holland, a concrete building for Barabise Health Centre has been constructed recently at Barabise Bazaar of Palpa district here.

The main building of the Health Centre, a guard house and also a beautiful garden on the premises of the Health Centre has been constructed with donations availed by a Holland-based foundation. The Foundation had provided the Health Centre with Rupees 1.3 million for the recently constructed building.

The newly constructed seven room building was jointly inaugurated recently by Maartin, although the Chairman of the Foundation at Holland and an Industrialist at the district, Jeet Bahadur Shrestha were not available.

"The students in Holland contributed the money to assist deprived people in rural Nepal by organising lottery programmes," said Maartin, at the inaugural ceremony.

It is known that the foundation has been providing health services in rural parts of the district for the past few years. The foundation launched a free health camp and a health post last month in which around two thousand people were the beneficiaries.

A total of 70 patients suffering from various diseases, attending the health camp in the district backed by the Foundation, underwent free surgical operations at hospitals in the capital, said sources at the Barabise Health Centre.

The foundation is also providing assistance in the construction of

drinking water projects and toilets in remote parts of the district, it is known.
