Commitment to serve people expressed

KATHMANDU, Feb. 4: The Vajra Foundation Nepal continues its commitment to service local people of Sindhupalchok district where it has been working since the past five years in various fields.

At a press meet organised here today on the occasion of its fifth anniversary, president of the foundation Ram Kaji Poudyal said that the people of the district have benefited greatly by the services of the foundation. He said that as the members of the foundation must work voluntarily, there were fewer people working with the foundation, although the number has been increasing yearly.

Chairman of Vajra Foundation, Holland Maarten Olthof said that the foundation was keenly interested in raising the living standard of the rural people in Nepal. He said that tourism in Nepal had greatly helped in improving the economic conditions of the people. To improve their income, Vajra Foundation Holland has been working in the field with its Nepal partner.

The foundation has been providing service in health, vegetable gardening, scholarships, building toilets and drinking water supply and constructions of schools buildings and health centres. In coordination with the Lutheran World Programme, the foundation has been distributing solar cookers to the Bhutanese refugees at Beldangi, a Bhutanese refugee camp in east Nepal.
